Admission Requirements

Admission to the master programme should strictly follow the senate legislation and other relevant rules and regulations of Dire Dawa University.

A student seeking admission to the Masters Program in Public Management and Policy shall have a basic working knowledge of public organizations.

- A first degree from a recognized college/university in the following disciplines, Public Administration and Development Management, related Business and Economics fields such as Business Administration, Business Education, Management, Accounting and Finance and Social Science fields such as Law, Political Science, Sociology, Psychology, Geography, History, Tourism and Civic and Ethical Education.
- Students from hard sciences might be admitted into the program considering if they have superior grade in their prior studies and perform very well on the entrance exam administered by the department of Public Administration and Development Management
- Secure a passing grade in the entrance examination conducted by the Department of Public Administration and Development Management.
- Should follow the admission and application procedures of Dire Dawa University.
- Provided that requirements A through C are fully fulfilled, special consideration will be given for women and persons coming from disadvantaged areas or regions of the country.
